

FREDERICK ADAMS HERITAGE CENTER

Listed more than a decade ago as one of Massachusetts' Most Endangered Historic Resources, the Kingston Public Library was reclaimed by the town and underwent a transformation to a heritage center and community gathering place. This archetypal Colonial Revival building was designed in 1898 by Joseph Everett Chandler, an MIT-trained "antiquarian" architect and a leading proponent of the Colonial Revival movement. The Town was committed to preserving and celebrating the building's striking architectural features while creating an accessible, functional venue.
