

PILGRIM MEMORIAL STATE PARK

Plymouth, MA

Coastal Engineering Co. is currently working with MA Department of Conservation and Recreation and Pressley Associates landscape architects to develop design and construction documents for the rehabilitation of Pilgrim Memorial State Park in 3 areas: Plymouth Rock Portico, Cole's Hill, and Pilgrim Mother Garden. The scope of services includes an assessment of the existing sites and memorial structures in order to evaluate the existing conditions and to identify repair options needed to rehabilitate the park while improving the function and patron's experience with minimal changes to the current design.

Civil/Site portion of the project is focused on general site grading and drainage upgrades and site improvements needed provide accessibility to the facility in the designated work areas. The Marine portion of the project is focused on the stabilization repairs to the existing seawall fronting the park, and the Structural portion of the project is focused on the conditions assessment of the existing memorial structures relative to repairs needed to correct any observed structural defects and conservation efforts relative to the historical monuments.
